Scituate High School is classified as high performing and sustaining and was also a Regents Commended School in 2002 and a RIDE Commended School in 2011 and 2012. Scituate High School, serving grades 9 - 12, housed on a 47 acre campus in a semi-rural area halfway between Providence and the Connecticut state line. The town is 55 square miles in area with 10,400 residents. The school also serves as a social center for the town, which is geographically divided by a reservoir. Scituate's population spans the full range of socio-economic conditions from the affluent to the disadvantaged. A significant number of Scituate residents are employed outside the town.
